EXTENDED LEARNING STATEMENT

The Swanton Local School District has been successfully providing in-person learning since August 19, 2020. At no time this year has the district been using a hybrid or fully remote approach. While we recognize that our students were impacted by the pandemic and the closure of school in the spring of 2020, our staff has been actively providing remediation for this missed learning all year long. Using internal assessment data our staff has devised a variety of remediation opportunities to help our students. For example, we have added tutors at different levels in the district to provide small group and one on one remediation. Additionally, the schedules at the middle school and high school have been altered to provide for a remediation period where students can receive one on one help with a teacher.

All year long our data teams have been monitoring student progress and identifying at-risk students for additional help. Planning is already underway to extend the tutoring services and remediation opportunities for the 2021-22 school year. Summer school and credit recovery services will be available this summer as usual. The elementary will be providing parents with information about an online program that will provided additional resources in reading and math for students that can be access over the summer. The Swanton Local School District looks forward to closing out the 2020-21 school year and preparing to welcome students back in August of 2021.
